NOTE: Novice Division is Yellow or 2 year of judo and below and will be created based on the number of entries.

- All weight division categories are subject to change depending on participants
- All contestants must compete in their own age and weight division prior to competing in a second division.
- The weight divisions will be determined upon receipt of entries. Contestants who exceed the maximum weight allowed for their age group will be placed in the next older age group. Excessive weight contestants will be determined at the discretion of the tournament committee. Coaches, Instructors, and Parents will have an opportunity to review the categories and confirm their child's/athlete's suitability for participation.

## Awards:

First, second, and third place awards will be given in each division. Awards will be presented after each division is completed. Contestants will be called to award presentation.

## Tournament Rules

Current International Judo Federation (IJF) contest rules with the following modifications:

1. Modified Double Elimination
2. Round Robin for Four (4) or Fewer Competitors.
3. Wins count First and Points Count Second in Round Robin Divisions.
4. Ippon = 10 Points, Waza-Ari = 5 Points, Hantei = 3 Points, Hansoku-Make = 10 Points
5. International Judo Federation Rules with the Following Modifications
  - o Arm Locks Permitted - Senior Brown/Black Belt Divisions Only
  - o Choking permitted - 13 Years Old and Above
6. Golden Score - 2 Minute Time Limit for Golden Score. Golden Score Will Be Used in All Divisions.
7. Rest periods - Rest Periods Will Not Exceed the Length of a Match.
8. The CARE System Will Be Used On All Competition Areas.
9. Co-Ed Competition for Children 10 Years Old and Younger may Occur Depending on the Number of Entries in Those Divisions.
10. Blue Judo Gis Are **NOT REQUIRED** for Junior Divisions but You Must Have a White Judo Gi
11. Blue Judo Gis **WILL BE REQUIRED FOR ALL** Senior Divisions Including Senior Novice
